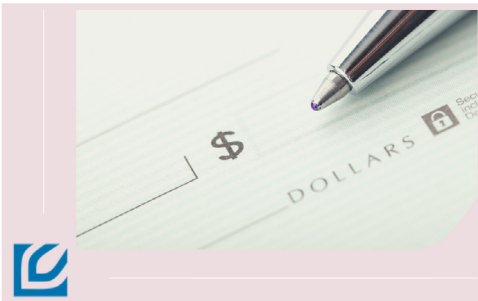
Don't let the first holiday of the fall season break your budget. Read on to discover ways to reduce those tricky costs.

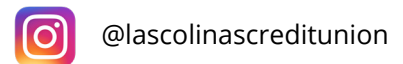
