GET SOMETHING BACK: PREMIER ACCOUNT

SCAM WATCH: IRS IMPERSONATORS

We want you to be aware of the rise in IRS impersonation scams. Fraudsters, posing as IRS officials, contact individuals via phone, email, or text, claiming they owe taxes and demanding immediate payment. These scammers often use threatening language and may seem convincing with manipulated caller ID information.

Remember, the IRS will never demand immediate payment, nor will they specify a payment method like a prepaid debit card or wire transfer. They also won't initiate contact via email, text, or social media for personal or financial information.

If you encounter such a scam, do not provide any details. Instead, report the incident to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration at TIGTA.gov and the IRS at irs.gov/phishing. Stay vigilant to protect yourself from these deceptive tactics.
